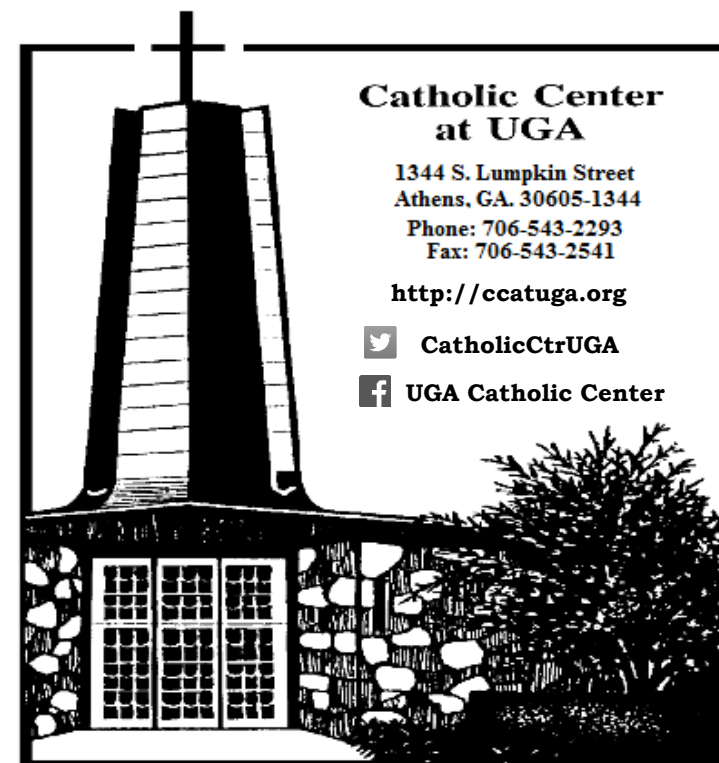

**Baptism:** Parents are required to attend a Baptism Preparation Class. Classes are held every month. Please contact the office to enroll.

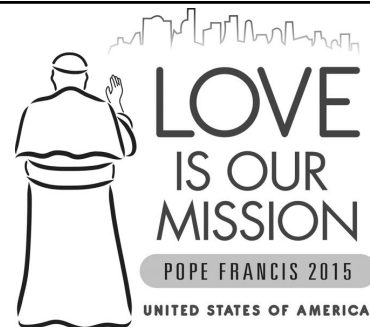
**Marriage:** Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Contact the office for an appointment.

Stop by the Center office during business hours for more information and to register. The \$250 fee includes transportation and lodging. \$125 is due at time of registration.

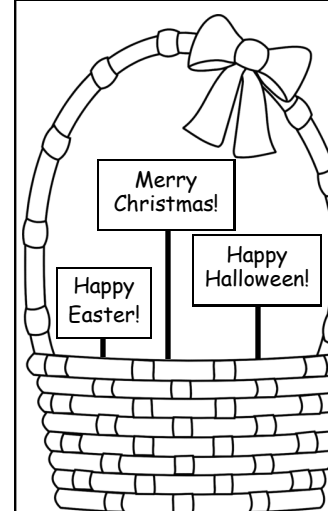
# VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES
