

- You must then enter your zip code, click on your favorite store, enter your email address, create a password, and agree to the terms and conditions
- You will then get a message to check your email inbox and click on the link within the body of the email.
- Click on My Account and use your email address and password to proceed to the next step.
- Click on Edit Kroger Community Rewards information and input your Kroger Plus card number. Update or confirm your information.
- Enter NPO number or name of organization (22875 or The Catholic Center at UGA), then select it from the list and click on confirm.
