- Click on Edit Kroger Community Rewards information and input your Kroger Plus card number. Update or confirm your information.

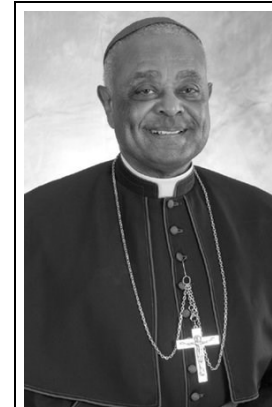
