- You must then enter your zip code, click on your favorite store, enter your email address, create a password, and agree to the terms and conditions
- You will then get a message to check your email inbox and click on the link within the body of the email.
- Click on My Account and use your email address and password to proceed to the next step.
- Click on Edit Kroger Community Rewards information and input your Kroger Plus card number. Update or confirm your information.
- Enter NPO number or name of organization (**22875** or **The Catholic Center at UGA**), then select it from the list and click on confirm.
- To verify you are enrolled correctly, you will see your organization's name on the right side of your information page.
- REMEMBER, purchases will not count for The Catholic Center until after your register your card(s).
- If you use your phone number at the register, you can call 800-576-4377, and select option 4 to get your Kroger Plus card number.
- Members must swipe their registered Kroger Plus card or use the phone number that is related to their registered Kroger Plus card when shopping for each purchase to count.
