**Korean Bible Study ~ New start time: 6:30PM**

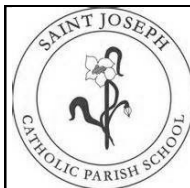

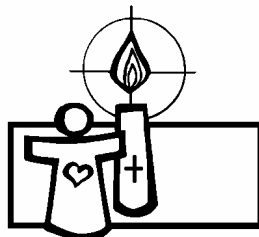
