



### Are you interested in becoming an Altar Server?

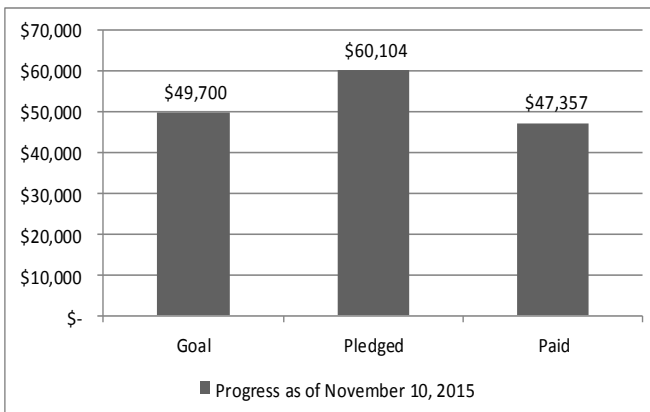

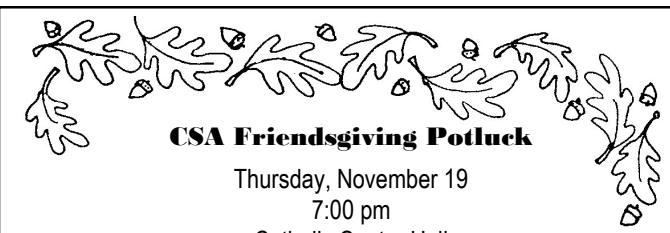
