**DREAM GROUP - Next Meeting February 14<sup>th</sup>**

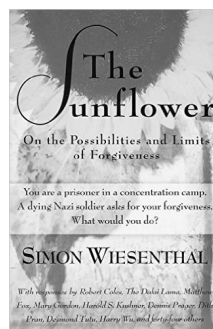
