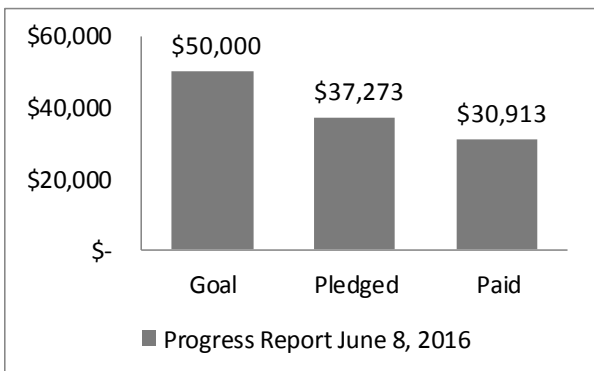

ARCHBISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL 2016 - "LOVE NEVER FAILS"
We are making some progress, but the Catholic Center still is short of sufficient pledges to meet our goal of \$50,000 for 2016. Statistics indicate that we must overachieve the goal in pledges to get sufficient payments to meet the goal. We are currently almost \$13,000 short of goal in total pledges and we have far fewer participants than in years past. Any shortfall at the end of the year will be paid out of the Catholic Center's operating expenses. However, if we exceed our goal, 100% of the excess will be returned to the Catholic Center for our use.
