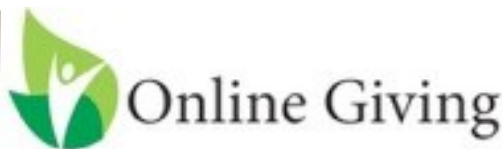

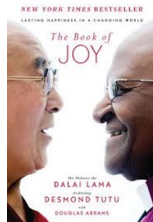
5K HUMAN RACE - SATURDAY, May 6th
