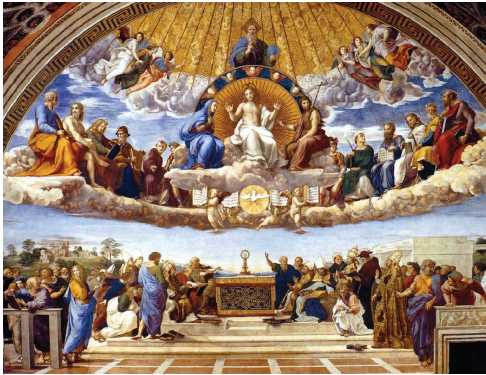


# THE CATHOLIC CENTER AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA

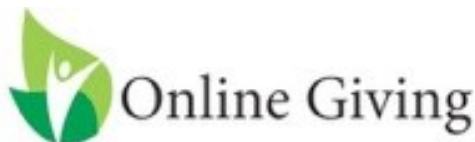
