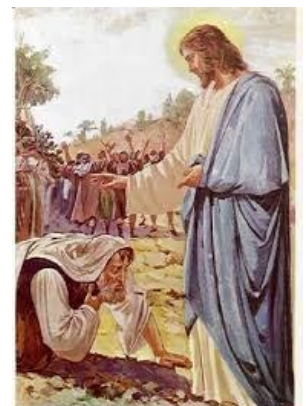


BLACK HISTORY MONTH
