THE SEASON OF LENT

We are reminded at Easter that we *renew* our baptismal promises and not *repeat* them. We are baptized *once for a lifetime* and not merely baptized *once in a lifetime*. Lent is the time of year set aside by the Church for us to prepare to renew these baptismal promises. Each time we enter a Catholic Church we bless ourselves with holy water, making the sign of the cross. We remember that we are baptized into the life of the Trinitarian God, believing in one God: the Father, the Son, and Holy Spirit all living a perfect communion of love. Our fidelity to baptism's grace draws us more and more into that divine communion of love. Through the Risen Christ, we become more divine by becoming more the person God created us to be. Baptism is not only a great gift from God for each of us personally, it is a gift to all humanity. We are not baptized only for ourselves. We are baptized for others. In fact we are baptized for all people. Our baptism commits each and all of us to help others come to know the great divine love in the Lord Jesus Christ.
