FRIARS TO GATHER MAY 29 FOR EXTRAORDINARY CHAPTER

Close to 200 friars of Holy Name Province are gathering next week for an Extraordinary Chapter to vote on whether or not Holy Name Province should join with five other US provinces to form one new province. On May 30, the friars of Holy Name as well as members of five other OFM provinces in the U.S. will vote on whether to unify. The participating provinces are Assumption BVM, headquartered in Wisconsin, Our Lady of Guadalupe in New Mexico, Sacred Heart in Missouri, St. Barbara in California and St. John the Baptist in Ohio. The outcome of the vote will be shared with the public via a post on www.USFranciscans.org. Fr. Frank and Fr. Bill ask for your prayers for all the friars next week as they engage, pray and discern the future as Franciscans here in the United States.
