#### THE CATHOLIC CHURCH AND CAPITAL PUNISHMENT

Pope Francis has ordered a change to the catechism of the Catholic Church, altering existing language to read "the death penalty is inadmissible because it is an attack on the inviolability and dignity of the person." It vows that the church will work "with determination for its abolition worldwide." "The new text, following in the footsteps of the teaching of John Paul II in 'Evangelium Vitae,' affirms that ending the life of a criminal as punishment for a crime is inadmissible because it attacks the dignity of the person, a dignity that is not lost even after having committed the most serious crimes," said Cardinal Luis Ladaria when announcing the change, according to the Catholic News Service.

Pope Francis said, "Recently my brother bishops here in the United States renewed their call for the abolition of the death penalty," Francis said. "Not only do I support them, but I also offer encouragement to all those who are convinced that a just and necessary punishment must never exclude the dimension of hope and the goal of rehabilitation."


