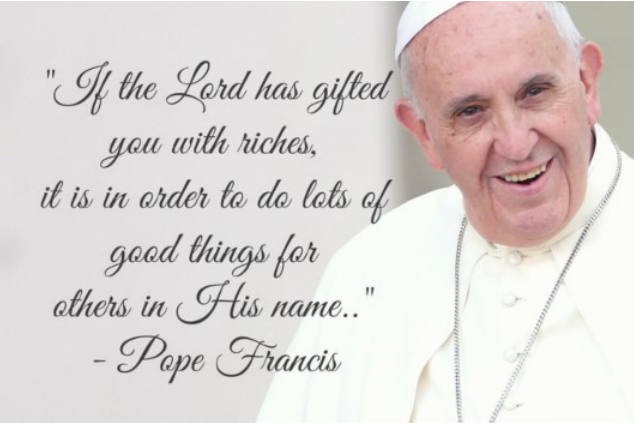
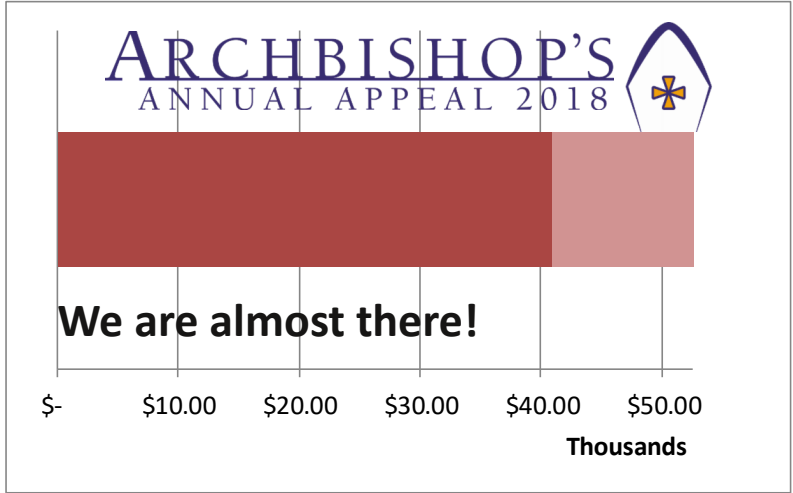




THE CATHOLIC CENTER AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA

Alternative Spring Break Trips

Our Campus Ministry has settled on their Alternative Spring Break Mission Trip locations. We will be serving in **Puerto Rico** doing building repair due to the aftermath of Hurricane Maria. We are partnering with Rebuilding Hope, a non-profit organization through the Archdiocese of Atlanta that does service retreats in Puerto Rico. The second trip will be to the **Arizona-Mexico** border with Borderlinks, serving those in need. The third service trip will be to the **Pine Ridge Native American Reservation** which is one of the poorest regions in the country. Finally, we will be doing a local mission trip to **Macon** with Rebuilding Macon. Our students will get to see Fr. Frank's old stomping grounds.

what's happening?

- ◇ Campus ministry is off to a busy start this school year. We have had **400-500 students** at our Sunday, 5pm Student Mass, with some Masses having standing room only!
- ◇ There is a brand new **student-led choir** which helps draw people deeper into the liturgy through music.
- ◇ **Archbishop Gregory** also visited in August to celebrate Mass and welcome new and returning students to the Catholic Center.
- ◇ After the Student Mass, we have a **weekly dinner** prepared by Fr. Frank and other volunteers from the community.
- ◇ To help build up the spiritual life of the students, we have **Adoration every Tuesday** evening. This is followed by Seeking Water, which is an hour of praise and worship with a student testimony.
- ◇ To reach out to the freshmen, we have an **Ignite group**. About 60-80 freshman and leaders come every week for a talk and a discussion. The past couple of weeks have been a "College Survival Guide" with topics such as how to remain Catholic in college and virtuous friendships.
- ◇ There is a brand new **Men's Ministry**, which had 17 students attend a men's weekend. This month they also had a Bacon and Cigar Night and another evening with a student witness talk.
- ◇ For upperclassmen, we have numerous Bible studies and the opportunity to serve on the CSA board.

TRANSITUS SERVICE TO BE HELD OCTOBER 3
