#### **Approaching a New Liturgical Year**

Luke is responsible for the Gospel of Luke and for the Acts of the Apostles. Throughout Luke's two-volume work there are certain themes that keep recurring. The first of these is universal salvation. Jesus' great mercy and forgiveness is the second theme especially in his concern for the poor, the marginalized, and the outcast. The third theme concerns the role of women. Women were often seen as second-class citizens in the world of the Gospels. Luke's Gospel is sympathetic to women and provides more passages concerning women than any other Gospel. Luke consistently portrays the women present in the stories as true examples of faith in spite of a culture that minimized women.

Our fourth theme focuses on the Holy Spirit and this continues in the Acts of the Apostles. Actions taken by the characters are frequently influenced by the direction of the Holy Spirit. Closely associated with this theme is prayer and throughout the Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles, people are often seen at prayer. When important events take place, the characters turn to God in prayer. When important decisions need to be made, the guidance of God is sought through prayer.

This year let us pray Luke together in our words and our actions. It is the most Franciscan of all the Gospels as we are presented with this Gospel of social concern and of inclusivity. (Catholic Australia).
