NOTE FROM OUR CSA DIRECTOR Dear Catholic Center Community,

I hope all of you are having a fruitful Advent! I can't believe I've completed my first semester as CSA Director here at the Catholic Center. I'm touched by how welcome you have made me feel, which has made my transition easier from moving from the Midwest to the south.

The past four and a half months have been very busy in campus ministry. We started our very first Welcome Week in August to connect both first year and returning students to the Catholic Center. Some of the events included "Taco 'bout Jesus Tuesday" where students learned about our Bible studies. There was "Chapel and Cookies" where students attended Mass and afterwards heard about opportunities for prayer. At the end of the week there was a Freshmen BBQ.

We have a number of weekly events that students participate in as well which will continue next semester. On Sundays there is the Student Mass, with a brand new student led choir. About 300-500 students attend each week, with a dinner afterwards. We served almost 3,000 meals over the course of the semester! There are also six different Bible studies for upperclassmen that meet off campus. Every Tuesday there was Seeking Water, a praise and worship night with a student testimony, which about 30 students attended. On Wednesdays the freshmen group Ignite met, and there were 60 students involved in that ministry.

Fall semester brought on other student ministry initiatives, such as the Men's Lake Weekend, Freshman Retreat, Student Ministry Fair, a bonfire with the Muslim Student Association and an Interfaith Friendsgiving. There were three service projects which included taking care of creation at the UGarden, sorting food at the Food Bank of North East Georgia and serving the homeless at Bigger Vision.

I want to thank all of you for your financial contributions and acts of service towards campus ministry at the Catholic Center this year. Many of you have helped with the Sunday Night Dinners each week. Others assisted with our exam week Late Night Breakfasts, where there were 600 meals served! You brought food to our Welcome Back BBQ, Ministry Fair and Late Night Breakfasts. This year the St. Francis Dinner was a fundraiser for our alternative break trips, and because of your generous donations, 28 students will be going on mission trips in March. I am so appreciative of your generosity and so are the students! Thank you for making a difference in the spiritual journey of the students at UGA.

I will be traveling home to Akron to spend Christmas with my family, and I look forward to seeing you after the New Year!


