#### "WHAT DOES IT MATTER?"

Each of our readings this week remind us that certain treasures are not worth keeping. What good, we might ask, is money when we are dead? It cannot bring us happiness, nor buy our way into heaven. But it's more than just money and material wealth: anything that does not bring us closer to God and God's people is useless folly. How true the words are of Qoheleth in our first reading: "All things are vanity!" When we find ourselves stressed, angry, sad, or anxious, weighed down by the many "things" in which we invest our lives, it might be helpful to ask a simple question: what does it matter? If something does not benefit God's kingdom, does not bring us closer to one another in love, then it's probably vanity, and we should give it up for true treasure in heaven.
