CATHOLIC QUESTIONS

Do I Have to go to Confession?

Here at the Catholic Center, we offer the sacrament of reconciliation on Wednesday, Saturdays, and by appointment. Many take advantage of God's grace of forgiveness through these means, but many do not. Which raises the question: how often does one have to go to confession?

According to canon law, "All the faithful who have reached the age of discretion are bound faithfully to confess their grave sins at least once a year" (canon 989). What's important to note is the canon's emphasis on "grave sins," or what many would call "mortal sins." Those who only commit "venial sins" are not bound by this yearly requirement. If one does not commit a mortal sin, they need not go to confession ever, if they so choose.

The reason for this is because the Eucharist is itself a form of forgiveness of sins. The Church teaches, "The Eucharist strengthens our charity, which tends to be weakened in daily life; and this living charity wipes away venial sins" (CCC 1394). Because Jesus died and rose again for the forgiveness of sins, the Eucharist is the primary means of

reconciliation, and all venial sins are remitted by receiving. So does mean that someone who commits only venial sins shouldn't go to confession (or isn't allowed to?) Of course not! Anyone who has sinned and feels contrition for their actions is welcome to the grace of the sacrament. The Church teaches that the sacrament reconciles us with the Church and strengthens our ability to turn away from sin, and anyone seeking those graces may receive it.
