Feast of the Epiphany

Following on the road of faith has many challenges and risks. The Maji show us this week of Epiphany the reality of choices and decisions. They teach us not with words but with deeds, not by what they say but by what they do. They have not sat around waiting. They are set on their way, they have left the security of their homes, what was familiar to them, where they are known and revered. They have acted decisively, they have not hesitated. If they had begun calculating, one by one, all the dangers, the unknowns of the journey, they would have lost the original determination and would have been lost in their concerns, they would never have started out. But they took a risk that changed their lives. Let's remember that one does not need to even leave their community to take the journey of the Magi. The journey is to see Christ in your midst and respond wholeheartedly. One last precious insight comes to us from the Magi. "Having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way." Changing one's life changes the way one takes. The encounter with Christ must bring about a turn, a

change of habits. Before we throw out our Christmas cards this year, possibly we should all take one last glace at the Nativity scenes on the covers of so many of these cards and ask ourselves, "Who are we in this journey of faith?" The egomaniac, Herod? The casual bystanders of life, the chief priests and scribes? Or the Magi, seekers of God willing to risk all for love of God?


