


PUT ON YOUR RUNNING SHOES! 42ND ANNUAL 5K HUMAN RACE

CATHOLIC QUESTIONS

When should the congregation stop kneeling after communion?

Technically speaking... there isn't a clear rubric for the action. The Roman Missal does not specify any proper posture, and the General Instruction of the Roman Missal simply says the following: "The faithful kneel after the Agnus Dei unless the diocesan Bishop determines otherwise. With a view to a uniformity in gestures and postures during one and the same celebration, the faithful should follow the directions which the deacon, lay minister, or priest gives according to whatever is indicated in the Missal."

In other words, not only is there not a proper time to stop kneeling, there is not a specific requirement to kneel at all during communion. What matters, as we can see from the instruction, is reverence and unity throughout the act. While people are still receiving communion, the congregation should be uniform in posture and one in voice as they sing. Local custom dictates what that should be.
