

#### **CATHOLIC OUESTIONS**

What's the difference between Franciscans, Jesuits, Dominicans, etc.?

While there is a difference between diocesan priests and religious priests (as was explained in a previous post) there are also differences among the religious priests. These differences are based on what is call a "charism."

Much like the word "charisma," the word charism finds its root in the Greek word for grace or gift. In a religious sense, a charism it represents a special character within a person to share a truth about God. Someone can have a charism for speaking, healing, teaching, caring for the poor, and so on. Each religious order has a central gift of

its founder that guides the way it lives today. In general terms, the charisms of the major orders are study and preaching (Dominicans), work and prayer (Benedictines), justice and discernment (Jesuits), contemplation and community (Carmelites), and humility and brotherhood (Franciscans).
