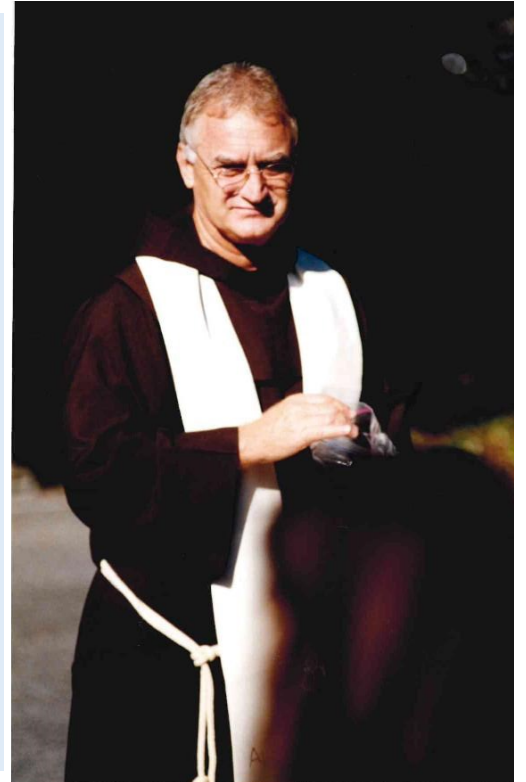
Pope Francis' Prayer Intentions for May:
