We have had such a lovely taste of fall these last few weeks! We hope you've been able to get outside and really enjoy the beautiful weather. It's football time here at UGA and for those able to attend the home games it should be a great time to be outside.

Thinking of outside, this week we discussed further options so that more parishioners can celebrate Mass here at the Catholic Center and especially so that they might be able to receive Eucharist.

Starting next weekend, October 17 and 18, we will reserve the parking lot between the church and parish center for those who may wish to attend Mass in their vehicles. Except for our handicap spaces, all others will be reserved in the area mentioned for the 5PM, 8 AM and 11AM Masses. A family or individual is welcome to live stream or listen to the outside church speakers in their vehicle while Mass is being celebrated and an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion will come out at communion time and distribute the Eucharist. You're asked to wear a mask and get out of your vehicle to receive. Now we have 3 options for celebrating Mass: in-person in our chapel or overflow in the center, Facebook or website live stream, or joining us in the parking lot.

We so look forward to the day when we can all be together in the church; but for now we are thankful for the above choices, that you might find a way to celebrate with us whether in person or spirit.

If you wish, you may bring chairs to sit outside of your car, but you must maintain a safe distance and wear a mask.
