Cudahy, an Adjunct Professor of Religious Studies at the University of South Carolina in Beaufort and author of the recently published From Blackmoor Lane to Capitol Hill: An Irish Capuchin's Influence on Bishop John England of Charleston, SC (St. Bonaventure, NY: Franciscan Institute Press, 2019).
