# A Message from Fr. Brian

Dear Catholic Community at UGA,

Go Braves! We had a braves watch party during the last game of the World Series. We had a bonfire with smores while the projector screen displayed the game outside. It was a historic moment for the Braves and a great evening together.

Last week, one of our students spoke on an inter-religious panel and represented the Catholic Center. She did a great job! I think of the scene where St Paul went to the Athens, Greece in Acts 17 and shared the gospel to the intellectuals in the Aereopogus. The student simply shared the gospel and her experience of incorporating the gospel into her life.

This coming week, our students are hosting a Thanksgiving dinner for the other religious organizations on campus. We've been interacting with the Church of Latter Day Saints as well as the Muslim Student Association. I recently invited all of campus ministries of UGA to join us!

We currently have over 125 students attending weekly Bible studies. Our FOCUS missionaries lead these groups. While it's not about the numbers, the amount of young people who are wanting to grow in their relationship with God is significant. It's very special to walk alongside them and cheer them on. They are inspiring!

Our student RCIA track has been going well. We have twelve students who are becoming Catholic. They come from various backgrounds and each have someone who is walking them along the process and attending the weekly sessions with them. It's a great time opening up the fundamentals of our faith.

A new season of our Catholic Dawgs Podcast is underway. They are conversations that I host with students about their faith and their lives. I believe that the young people's faith shouldn't be held under a bushel basket but ought to shine brightly for all to see. They are captivating and fun conversations.
