# A Message from Fr. Brian

Dear Catholic Center Community,

As we begin Lent, I want to invite you to our Penance Service this upcoming Monday. Our penance service is a time where we all confess our sins and make more room for the love of God in our lives. Perhaps you haven't been in a while! Or perhaps you've been carrying stuff around with you in your soul for a long time. Confession is a great way to move forward in our walk with Jesus.

Lent is a season of stepping forward towards God. This is what we mean by the word "conversion." John the Baptist always preached conversion by saying, "prepare the way for the Lord!"

We are always in need of ongoing conversion, or always needing to step close towards God. We can do this by confession, or almsgiving, serving the poor, and by means of prayer. I always encourage what I term 'honest prayer.' What is going on in your life and how is it sitting with you? What are some desires you have these days? Are there any fears that are weighing you down? What is frustrating you? Is there anything preventing you from something you feel called to? These are great questions for reflection and great content for prayer! Honest prayer vocalizes what's on our hearts and what we are currently going through. Praying with this relevant content allows us to step forward towards Christ and allows God to come into the everyday content of our lives!

Lent is also a season where we try to go without something or to do more of something. This emphasizes the penitential nature of the season. And these actions are in and of themselves a prayer! They are the expressions of our heart's desire.

We pray with our bodies during the season of Lent by going without or doing more of something. Like how we pray with our bodies at Mass (standing, sitting, kneeling, eating, singing, and speaking), so also is abstaining or withholding a physical embodiment of prayer!
