Dear Catholic Center Community,

During UGA Spring Break, I had an opportunity to make an 8-Day Silent Retreat in Philadelphia. I normally make this annual retreat in the summer, but it was a very special gift to have it at the beginning of Lent. I would like to share with you something from the retreat in hope that you might find it also helpful in your own Lenten journey. I started my retreat with the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the prayer Anima Christi. In contemplating the Heart of Jesus, I was drawn to the tenderness of Jesus' heart that gently whispered "[1] loved [my] own in the world and [1] loved them to the end" (John 13:1). It is this selfless love that yearns for our return when we wander off. It is also this selfless love that flows into our heart that heals it, transforms it, and enables it to love others as He loved us. The prayer Anima Christi I have prayed many times in my life, but this time I prayed it differently, that is, by listening to Jesus praying this prayer to me.

> "May all that is me flow into you. May my body and blood be your food and drink. May my passion and death be your strength and life. With me by your side enough has been given. May the shelter you seek be the shadow of my cross. Please do not run from the love which I offer. I will hold you safe from the forces of evil. On each of your dyings I will shed my light and my love. I will keep calling to you until that day comes When with my saints, you may praise me forever." Amen.

I cannot even tell you which line was dearest to me because all of it spoke to me so profoundly. My hope in sharing this experience with you is so that we can encourage one another during this Lent to know how much Jesus loves us and that his love transforms our hearts and world. Through the pierced heart of Jesus, let us trust in His redeeming love for all those who are suffering greatly in Ukraine and Russia.
