Dear Catholic Center Community,

We are in need of some individuals to participate in a couple specialized committees: a "Campus Development Committee" and a "Communications Committee." These two committees require individuals to have specialized experience and knowledge. It is an opportunity to give back to the Catholic Center and lead in a unique way. The Campus Development Committee seeks to establish plans and take steps toward developing a Catholic Center campus that meets the needs of today's and future generations. The development of these committees is our next step in our Strategic Plan implementation here at the Catholic Center!
