Dear Catholic Center Community,

We are in need of some individuals to participate in a couple specialized committees: a "Campus Development Committee" and a "Communications Committee." These two committees require individuals to have specialized experience and knowledge. It is an opportunity to give back to the Catholic Center and lead in a unique way. The Campus Development Committee seeks to establish plans and take steps toward developing a Catholic Center campus that meets the needs of today's and future generations. This is done by assessing the facilities, developing a prioritized master plan that is in sync with our needs, and to establish a phased short and long-term plan to upgrade facilities (such as our Catholic Center building, meeting areas parking lot, and our Catholic Center church). The Communications Committee seeks to expand awareness of the Catholic Center and deepen engagement with constituents. They will assess internal and external communications, develop internal communications plan for staff, increase awareness of the Catholic Center in the UGA community, develop an external communications plan to reach key constituencies and deepen their engagement (such as alumni, students, local members), as well as to those who do not attend the Catholic Center.

With the help of 360 members of our community who have shared their thoughts during this process, we have finished our mission statement and our vision statement. Thank you all for your participation in this! Our new mission statement is that "we are a welcoming Eucharistic Community for the University of Georgia students faculty, staff, alumni and friends that fosters growth in the Catholic Faith." Our new vision statement is that we are "a diverse, vibrant Catholic community nurturing faith, building fellowship and engaging in service." The development of these committees is our next step in our Strategic Plan implementation here at the Catholic Center! 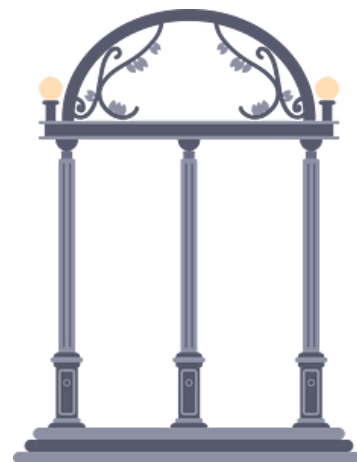
