Dear Catholic Center Community,

Jesus said to them, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; ask the master of the harvest to send laborers for His harvest. ... but rejoice because your names are written in heaven." -Luke 10:2, 20

If I'm being honest, I don't remember much from going to Mass on Sundays while I was growing up; I do, however, remember two things: the images of wheat that Jesus frequently used, and thinking to myself, "I don't ever want to become a priest." In hindsight, especially as I reflect on my entire life and how I've now wound up in Athens, this tension of wheat and Eucharistic imagery and always feeling hesitant to become a priest has actually led to much growth in my life. The road to priesthood and during it have been anything but easy – difficult to say the least, but this life has also been incredibly profound.

For me, the tension between loving the Eucharist and not wanting to become a priest came face to face, right here in Athens. I remember sitting in one of the pews at the Catholic Center my sophomore year, reflecting on how God is probably (just a little bit) smarter than I am, and asking Him what I should do with my life. To that question, I heard God say, "Priesthood." And I ran away from that call for a while.

Very gently yet persistently did I hear God call my name, over and over. There began to be something growing in my heart, much more profound than wheat. My name is written in God, and, while I may have taken His, He has never taken my name in vain. Him calling my name – in my existence, in the small invitations of my life have all been laden with purpose, and Athens has been the place where all of this has unfolded – to be back here is so surreal. God has made a lot of promises, "rejoice because your name is written in heaven," and this fidelity is the rejoicing that bears much fruit – even right here at UGA. I'm grateful to be here with you all!
