On home game Saturdays:

NO MASS. There is no Vigil Mass, Reconciliation, or activities at the Center from 8PM on Friday until the 8AM Mass on Sunday morning. The Chapel and Center will be closed for use on home football game days.

NO PARKING. The Catholic Center parking lots will be locked at 8PM on Friday and reopen for the 8AM Mass on Sunday morning. Our lots are used for contract parking, so **towing will be enforced** during these times.



A Message from Sr. Catherine:

Dear Catholic Center Community,

Happy Fall- it's official! Perhaps the arrival of a new season holds a gentle invitation to renewal and fresh perspective and hope in some area of our life. May you be blessed as you step forward into that.

This week's readings are a grateful and hope-filled cry to the God who makes right that which is badly broken and calling out for justice. In the midst of abundant evidence of human capacity for blindness, sinfulness and cruel indifference, God's light shines forth as hope for the lowly and the poor, the despised and the voiceless. The psalmist, glimpsing God's liberating and healing presence, cries out "Praise the Lord, my soul!" These words, which we often sing together, are reminiscent of Mary's words in the Magnificat as she marvels at God's wonderfully subversive love- love that lifts, dignifies, reveals things as they are, rectifies and restore, often in ways far beyond what we can hope for, with strength and with delicate care.

As we look around at our world and as we contemplate our own lives, marked as they are with beauty, struggle, joy and very real pain, may we do so with audacious hope. May we ask with humble confidence for what we need and for the many needs of our world. May we have the courage to ask God how we might be invited to participate in his healing work, and to listen for the response.
