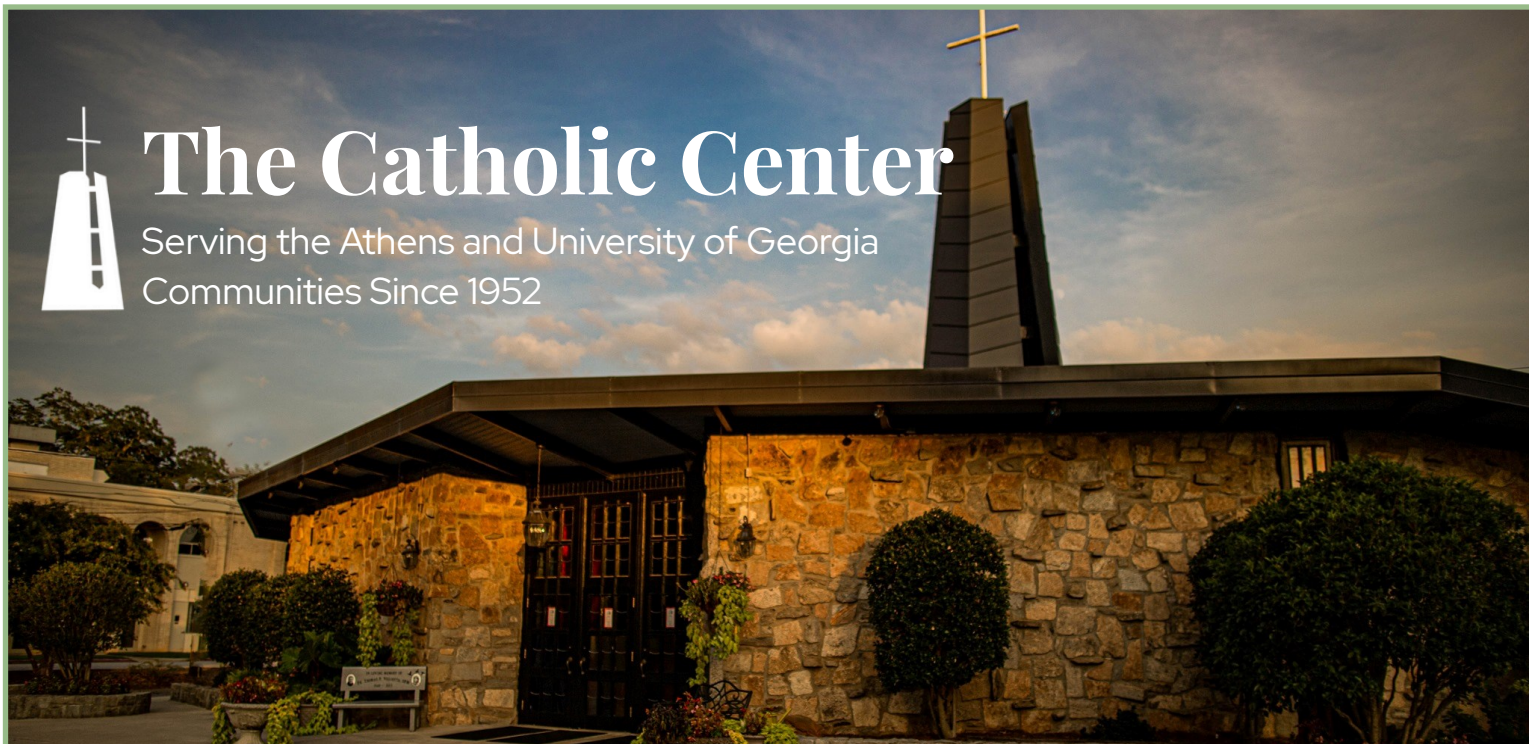

## A Message from Sr. Catherine

Dear Catholic Center Community,  
Please join me in praying for and with our RCIA participants, Katelyn, Austin, Chase, James, Lane, Dixie, Mandula, Scott, Maya and Clay, who will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance and Welcome this Sunday at the 10:30am mass! As they take this step toward the sacraments of initiation or toward full communion in the Catholic Church, the prayers and support of the community are essential and bear witness to the joy of the Gospel. The candidates, likewise, minister to all of us with their witness of hope and courage in embarking on this journey of faith. Let's give thanks for what God is doing in and through each one of us and in this community!

Last week a second grader in our community asked me some questions about faith and vocation and gifted me with a popsicle stick crucifix after we talked. She asked very good questions and her simplicity, earnestness and openness touched my heart. I was reminded of Jesus' insistence on the importance of "becoming like children" so as to be open to receive the invitation of participation in the Kingdom of God.

This week's readings point to the need and the gift of being rooted in humble and hopeful truth before God. It would not be a stretch to say that we are all "beggars" before the One who gives us everything that we have and are. When we forget this basic truth and start to trust more in our personal strength, wealth or goodness, we quickly get turned around- pride and fear move in and gum things us. And yet, time and again, we see that the Lord has no desire to humiliate us, but only to help us open up to receive even more - more understanding, hope, joy, to receive Life. Coming to know and believe this is what casts out fear and allows us to be open and exposed and small before the Lord and so discover true strength and security. It makes our littleness and our need sweet rather than bitter. It makes us less harsh and more generous. When we recognize that we are received and sustained by the One who is tenderness and truth, Life which has conquered death, we can live more fully. That's good news!
