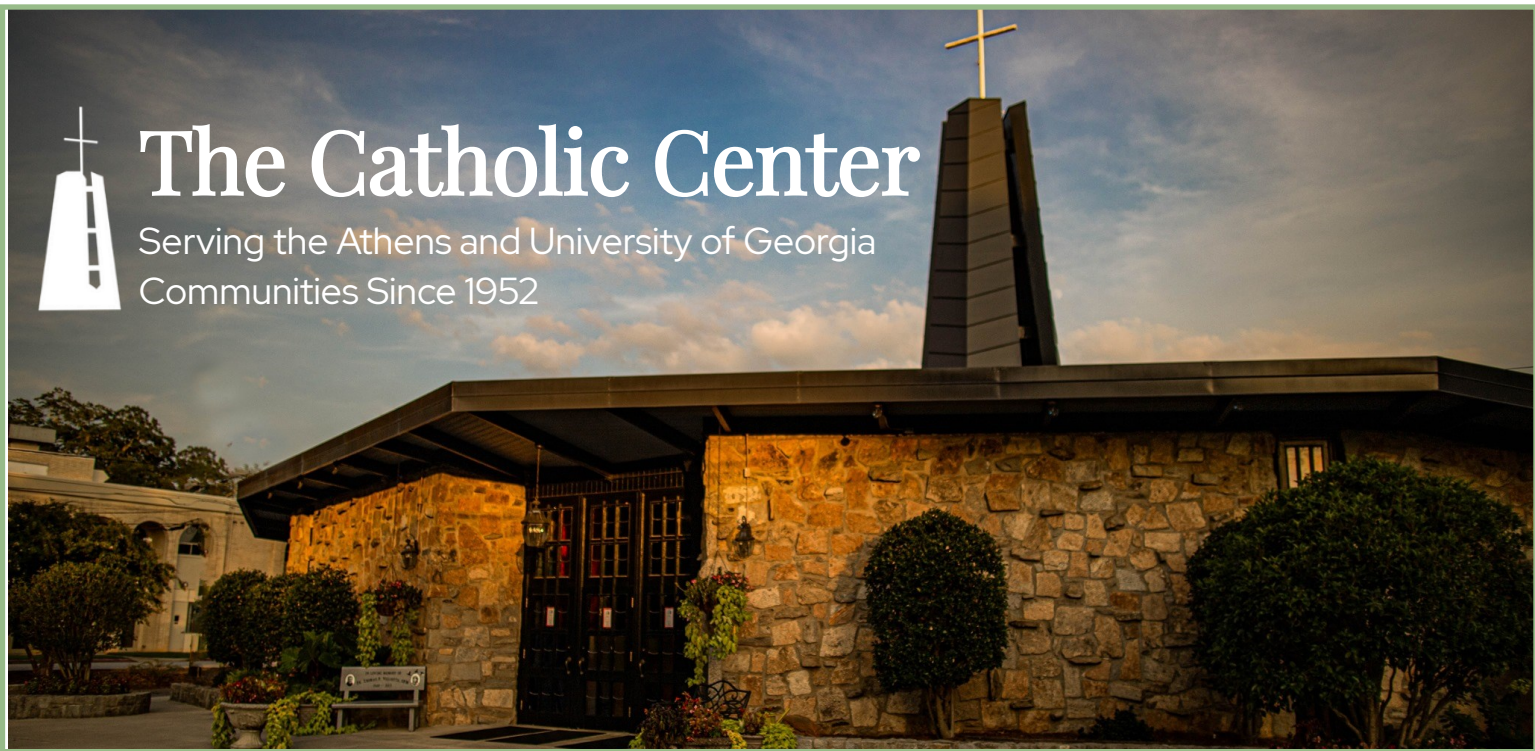

Day of Prayer & Reflection

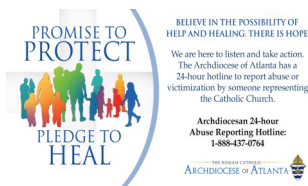
