Dear Catholic Center Community,

Over the course of Advent, the prophet Isaiah gives us many incredulous and wonderful images:

They shall beat their swords into pruning hooks...

The wolf shall be the guest of the lamb...

There shall be no harm or ruin on all My holy mountain...

The desert and the parched land will exult...

they will bloom with abundant flowers...

But I'm asked, in today's Gospel, why it is I'm here:

What did you go out to the desert to see?... Why are you here at Church today?

A reed swayed by the wind?... To see something weak?

Someone dressed in fine clothing?... To see something powerful?

No. My heart longs to see something more; it asks:

Jesus, are You the One who is to come, or should we look for another?

Are You the One for whom we've been waiting, or should we begin to wait for someone else?

As difficult as this longing is, it - in and of itself - proposes a joy: no one else has proposed so audacious a claim.

And there begins to an invitation to expand my imagination:

The resentment in my own heart could turn into a fruitful yield ...

There might be a place of fulfillment for me ...

The realities once abandoned could be full of life again ...

I'm here not because my images of the world or my imagination have been bold or wonderful, but because there is a One who isn't looking for another: I'm here because there is One who has anticipated me.
