Dear Catholic Center Community,

I started at the Catholic Center roughly one month ago and what I am most grateful for is this community's warmth, thoughtfulness, and beautiful faith. If we have not had the chance to meet, here's a brief introduction (and if we have already met, please bear with me as I continue to connect names to faces)!

I grew up in Ocean Springs, Mississippi, which is adjacent to the more well known city of Biloxi. My older sister and I were avid about the arts; my wonderfully generous mother split her time between homeschooling and driving the two of us to all over the Mississippi Gulf Coast for our music lessons, dance lessons, and orchestra and community theatre rehearsals.

This past May, I graduated with my Bachelor's of Music in Piano and Vocal Performance from Loyola University New Orleans. Attending a Jesuit university and being steeped in the Catholic culture of New Orleans, grew and transformed my faith throughout my four year stint in the Crescent City. I started singing at St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church during my sophomore year. It was there that I found my first church home, began learning about the beauty of the Catholic liturgy, and fell in love with the mass. Most Sundays in college, you could find me singing at the St. Francis masses in the morning and then at Loyola's student mass in the evening! After two years of deep discernment, I made the decision to enroll in RCIA during my senior year, and was confirmed in the Catholic Church this past Easter. I can easily say it was the best decision I have ever made.

After graduation and my confirmation into the Church, my post grad plans looked different than I expected. God guided me here to Athens towards the end of the summer, where I enrolled in a one semester certificate program for Audio Production at Tweed Recording studios. From August through December, I was working and learning in the studio with a wide variety of artists. My roles ranged from assisting engineer, to music producer, to a recording musician running into the live room and playing piano for someone's song. I have a strong interest in composition and plan to begin self-publishing now that I am equipped with a strong knowledge in music recording.

Towards the end of my program at Tweed, I was unsure where I was headed next. Thankfully, God called me to stay in Athens and be part of this incredible community at the Catholic Center. I could not be more thrilled to grow my faith with all of you.
