# Feed My Starving Children MobilePack Event Update

Due to pieces of the ceiling in Stegeman Coliseum falling to the floor, UGA has closed the building until repairs are made which could take several months. We are working with the Athletic Association and FMSC to move the event to another facility and reschedule the event as close to April 1-2 as possible. We hope to have clarity on the new date some time next week. Once we have a firm new date, existing volunteer reservations will be switched to the same times and volunteers will be asked to confirm if that time still works for them.

We still need help with donations. Current donation status: \$23,237 vs. goal of \$35,000. It takes very little to make a difference: \$106 to feed a child for a year and \$365 feeds a family for a year. The UGA Athletic Assoc. will host private tours for sponsors of the \$80 mil. football facility and Stegeman Coliseum and sponsors are invited to attend a football practice.
