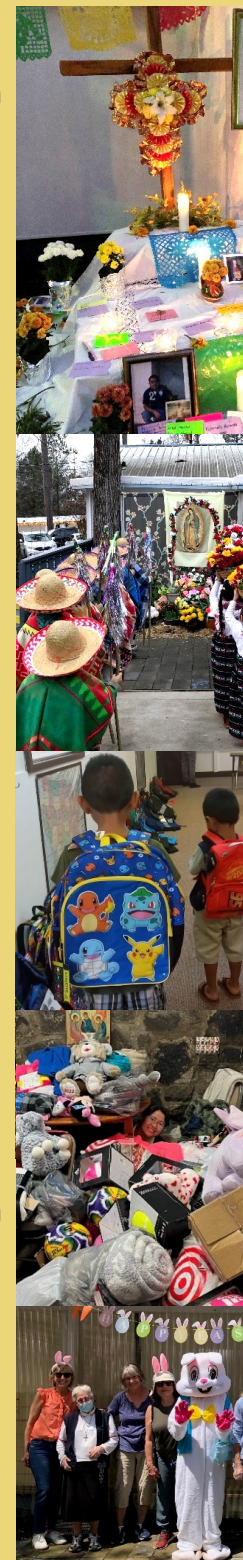

Dear Catholic Center Community and Supporters of Oasis Ministries!

As we conclude this academic year, we would like to take this moment to count our blessings and give thanks to God and to all of you for the many ways you have supported Oasis from the Catholic Center.

Your gifts helped ease the burden of the rising cost of living by allowing us to continue our monthly distribution of over 10,000 pounds of food, and provide backpacks for the new school year, jackets and heaters for the winter, gifts for Christmas, and candies and joy at our Easter egg hunt. Our convent is always stocked with rice and beans and diapers of all sizes donated by many of you. We have welcomed more than seven new families to the neighborhood and helped to get them settled in their new homes by assisting them with the basic needs. With high inflation, we also provided occasional aid with rent and utility bills, and helped pay for roof replacement.

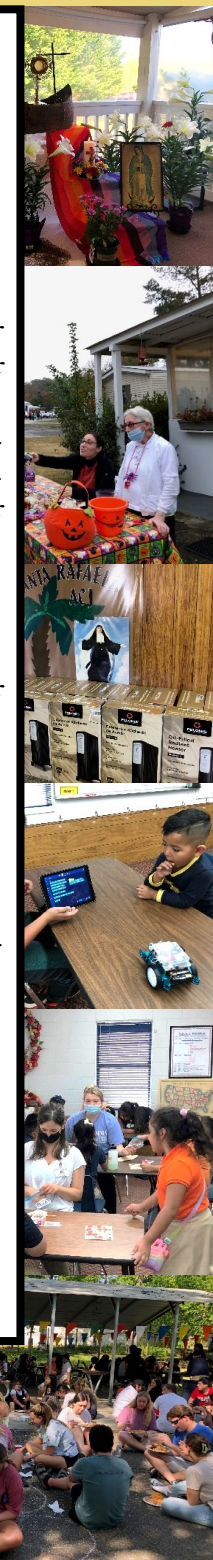
Your donations also supported the daily running of Oasis' afterschool program. This school year we had 60 elementary students enrolled and over 130 UGA students who helped with tutoring each semester.
