Dear Catholic Center Community,

Something that I'd like to do is have our wonderful church community get to know our staff. I've started incorporating other staff members into our weekly bulletin note. We are working on taking staff photos and displaying them upon entry of the Catholic Center so that they can be more known. We currently have 2 priests, 1 religious sister, 4 college students and 9 lay professionals on our staff. We are blessed to have such a great team of people. Please feel free to come by and introduce yourself to them.

This past year, we created a development department in our Catholic Center office. This has been made up of 2 lay professional volunteers, 3 college students, and 1 priest. We have been working to grow our Catholic Center alumni database, enhance our communication, build a network of support, invite friends and family to become benefactors, and always being good stewards of our resources. We recently hired a catholic development consultant called PETRUS to help steer and coach our development team in the right direction. We meet every two weeks with the consultant from PETRUS and it had been helpful. Our mission is to invest in our church for generations to come, so that the Catholic Center can be a blessing to so many.

As we begin the new start of the school year, I encourage you to get to mass early as our parking situation is limited. In September, we have 4 weekends of football home games - which means that most of our parishioners who regularly attend our 5pm vigil mass will be attending our Sunday Services.
