A Message from Fr. Brian

Dear Catholic Center Community,

As most of you know, our sound system has been broken. This has been a constant frustration. Our sound system has had many issues and it's often quite the distraction.

Fortunately, so many people have been helpful in this area. Many of you with experience have reached out to give professional advice. I've consulted with many people to assess the situation. Many of you have offered your support.

I want to thank all of you in our community for your patience and understanding. I want to thank our hearing impaired community who have been very patient.

But there is good news: we have finally settled on a company to partner with we have settled on a sound system to invest in. After consulting with many companies, getting proposals and expert opinions, we are confident in the direction we are going.

We have received permission from our finance council to move forward and we received permission as well as encouragement from the Archbishop in Atlanta. While we expect the process to take a couple more months for the company to get the equipment, test it, and do the install, we are excited the momentum.

The company that we have unanimously agreed to contract is Atlanta Sound Works. The total cost for the project is \$72,036.96. This will include a brand new sound system that we hope to carry with us for decades into the future.

Again, I want to thank you for your patience and understanding. Its an exciting step for us as we move forward to less disruptions and better clarity during our weekend celebrations.
