A Message from Fr. Michael

Dear Catholic Center Community,

Beloved, we are God's children now; what we shall be has not yet been revealed.
We do know that when it is revealed we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. -1 Jn 3

"You have no idea how good, true and beautiful you are." It's the people who love us most that are able to see deepest into us, and sometimes it can be difficult to believe them. In fact, the fact that they would even make such an audacious claim about our lovableness can oftentimes make us feel even more alienated – our response is something like: if you knew what went on in here then you wouldn't say that, if you knew my past then you wouldn't say that.

So, when God invites the Church to celebrate All Saints every first of November, it's a reminder to you, yes, YOU, who are reading this bulletin - whether this is your millionth time in church, or your first - that you are invited to become a Saint. Not simply "stumbling" your way into Heaven or just happening to take all the "correct directions" to the Place - but actually canonized.

Have an excuse? So did Paul. So did Peter. So did Mary of Magdala. The difference was that they didn't allow that excuse to get in the way; rather, the very excuse itself became a place of communion with God. Paul was persecuting the Church, and Jesus met him there. Peter denied Jesus, and Jesus met him there. Mary M. had a lot of darkness in her life, and Jesus met her there. A Person came to them, and they came to believe.

"... what we shall be has not yet been revealed" (1 Jn 3). We can look into the mirror to tell us who we are, but it can't tell the full story. We could look to our past, but it can't tell the full story. We can look into the face of another to tell us who we are, but they can't tell the full story. But when we look into the Face of God, here is the whole story. The Smile He gives to us - at our creation, when He sustains us, and when He will fulfill us - tells us who we truly are. Maybe this Smile communicates to you who you truly are - one day, a Saint.
