## A Message from Lynn

### **Dear Catholic Center Community,**

Jesus said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." Then they abandoned their nets and followed him. Mk 1:14-20

Think honestly to yourself on how you would have answered Jesus.

In today's time, there would be many interesting responses as to why few people do not "leave all" to follow a dream or to pursue a noble goal. Perhaps, some are afraid to become what they can be, while some are only thrilled at the possibility, but then shudder at the thought.

Mark's Gospel tells us of the call of Peter, Andrew, James and John. When we hear about their call, why did these fishermen respond so readily to Jesus' request? Could the reason be that they heard Jesus speak before and were drawn to His message, to pursue a noble goal, requiring them to commit a personal conversion? How hard was it for them to give up their livelihood as fishermen, family, and responsibilities? In that "surrendering moment," you must give yourself entirely to Him and ask God to take over your life. It is an experience of God's grace that does what one could never do alone.

John Henry Newman went to Rome to discern if Jesus was calling him to follow Him as a Roman Catholic. On his return, he prayed, "Lead me, O Lord! ... I cannot see the way ... Lead, kindly light." The words brought such peace to him that he took a pencil and began to write. When finished, he had written the lyrics to the famous hymn: "Lead, Kindly Light." Upon his return to England, he entered the Catholic Church and became one of its greatest leaders. He was canonized into sainthood on Oct. 19, 2019.

We are in Ordinary Time, and we are ordinary followers of Christ. Jesus invites us to take one step up and become extraordinary and to give our lives completely to Him. How can you take that step up in faith and follow Jesus more closely?

What I am is God's gift to me. What I become is my gift back to God.
