### Dear Catholic Center Community,

Last Saturday was our 46<sup>th</sup> Annual Human Race. At first, I was a little hesitant about having the race during Lent because I did not want it to be seen as having a "party" during the penitential season. However, as I reflect on it now, I find that there are many connections between the two. The race brings to my mind the words of the Saint Paul to the Corinthians (9:25), "Every athlete exercises discipline in every way. They do it to win a perishable crown, but we an imperishable one." I was amazed at the many participants who finished the 5K in a very impressible time whether by running or by walking. These athletes must have disciplined themselves and exercised regularly to finish the race so well. It was a beautiful and fun event, celebrating the community. During this Lent, may we run together toward the loving embrace of our Lord Jesus Christ!
