#### Dear Catholic Center Community,

Happy 32nd Sunday! The first full week of November has been dedicated as National Vocation Awareness Week by the US Bishops. It is an annual week-long celebration dedicated to promoting vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life through prayer and education, and to renew our prayers and support for those who are considering one of these particular vocations.

Each one of us has a personal vocation. A vocation is that which God uses to direct each and every one of us to a unique way of building God's kingdom in the world. Each one of us is hand-picked, called by name by Jesus, for this particular mission. In the hidden recesses of the human heart the grace of a vocation takes the form of a dialogue. Christ calls the person by name and says: "Come, follow me." As a community, especially one that sits on the campus of a university, we can help our young people to discern their vocations by our prayers and encouragement.

I would like to share with all of you a story from my own journey. Shortly after my vocation discernment I shared with my parents that I felt God was calling me to the religious life. I cannot forget my dad's reaction. Right after my announcement to the family at dinner, my dad slowly got up from the table and walked over to his couch in silence. The next day I asked my dad, "Why are you so sad? You are the vice-president of the group of parents whose mission is to pray for vocations." He was silent for a moment and then he said to me, "But I always prayed for my neighbors' kids." I know for certain that he is happy for me and is praying for vocations now from heaven.

I hope this funny story will motivate you to pray for young men and women discerning their vocations, especially to the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life. Let us also pray for all those are committed or on their journey, in a special way let us remember Deacon Colin Patrick, Seminarian Mark Piendel (UGA Grad'22) and Sister Catherine Kirwan-Avila.

We thank you for calling men and women to serve in your Son's Kingdom as priests, deacons, and consecrated persons. Send your Holy Spirit to help others to respond generously and courageously to your call. May our community of faith support vocations of sacrificial love in our youth and young adults. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever.
