## A Message from Oasis

### **Dear Catholic Center Community,**

As the school year comes to an end, we would like to take this opportunity to express our deep gratitude for the many ways that the Catholic Center has supported our ministries at Oasis. Some of you have sustained us with your monthly contribution whether it is by checks or online giving. Others have responded so generous whenever there was a drive for Oasis. We would like to highlight some of ways that you help our brothers and sisters in the area.

Last Saturday, we distributed 13,000 pounds of food to 121 families, and this helped feed over 500 people, many of whom are children. With your financial support, we have been able to hold monthly food distribution every third Saturday throughout the year. The long line of cars begins at the break of dawn. Most of the families live in Athens-Clarke while others come from as far as Comer and Lavonia.



On April 18, we had our last day of Oasis tutoring. Your support helps us run an afterschool program for over 60 elementary children within the trailer park. For each semester, we recruit over 125 UGA students (many from the Catholic Center) to tutor our kids 4 days a week. With the help of these dedicated tutors, these students receive the help they need to do the homework and to advance their skills in reading, writing and arithmetic. Your contribution supports the development of students and comforts the hearts of their parents who are not able to help their kids academically because of the language barrier.



Throughout the

year, all of you have responded so generously to our different drives. For the Easter Egg Hunt, you bought in so many bags of candies. For Christmas, you overfilled the Catholic Center with gifts and gift cards. For the new academic year, you prepared the kids for school with beautiful and durable backpacks. During the ordinary days, you shared your lightly used items from clothing to kitchen supplies to furniture. For all that you do and for who you are, we want to say THANK YOU on behalf of all those we serve and give THANKS TO GOD for this wonderful community of the Catholic Center.
