A Message from Fr. Brian

Friends,

I am thrilled to share with you a recent news article highlighting the inspiring journeys of nearly a dozen University of Georgia graduates from our Catholic Center, who are pursuing missionary work. Among these dedicated young adults is Ethan Dawidowicz, a finance graduate who has committed three years to the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). This summer, Ethan will be in Lincoln, Nebraska, focusing on spiritual, human, and intellectual formation before his missionary assignment. Ethan's enthusiasm for the fellowship and brotherhood with other missionaries is truly heartening. FOCUS, with its 26-year presence on over 250 campuses, continues to engage students through Bible studies, mission trips, and evangelization efforts.

Additionally, three graduates will join the Ohio-based Damascus ministry, and another three will work with Life Teen, one of the largest national youth programs for Catholic teens. Johnny Ede, inspired by Life Teen camp missionaries, will begin full-time missionary work this fall, guiding young people on their spiritual journeys. With his degree in business management and minor in Spanish, Johnny's dedication to fostering community and encouraging others to get involved is remarkable. These students embody the missionary heart we strive to cultivate here at the Catholic Center.

Our Catholic Center, which has served students for 60 years, continues to be a nurturing ground for faith and community life. It is truly inspiring to see our students responding to the call of the Holy Spirit with such zeal and commitment. Their desire to serve and evangelize reflects the vibrant and active presence of the Holy Spirit within our community. I am incredibly proud of their dedication and the profound impact they will have on the lives they touch. Let us continue to support and pray for these young missionaries as they embark on their journeys, bringing the light of Christ to others.
