Dear Catholic Center Community,

I have been traveling this week in Montana with my little sister. She works at a Big Sky resort in Montana with FOCUS Summer Projects. Every day, we have an hour of adoration and mass. During my time of prayer, I have been reading “He and I” by Gabrielle Bossis. She was a Catholic French woman in the early 1900s who wrote this book because Jesus told her to tell everyone what He was saying to her. He said He did not want His people to be afraid of Him anymore; He wanted them to be in love.

Whenever she heard Christ’s voice, she wrote down what He said. All of her conversations with Him are so simple. I was amazed by how simple yet powerful His words to her are. Jesus tells her, “Let us constantly talk to each other” and “Be one with me. Be one with me. Be one with me.” And “I already know your humanity.”

These are just a few phrases I have pondered, but one concept has struck me more than the rest. This week, I have focused on the idea that God has His way of loving me because He is love itself. He does not think to Himself, “How do I say this in a way that Melina will feel loved?” He says it because He just loves. He does not decide how to love us; it flows from Him.

This led to a further discovery: my love comes from His love. With that in mind, I do not have to decide how to love people; I can be grounded in the fact that the way I love people is specific to who I am, not how others will perceive it.

I look forward to bringing this new revelation back home to Georgia with me after my week of adventures in the mountains of Montana.
