Exciting Update from St. Joseph Catholic Church

Dear Friends.

We are excited to share an update from our neighbors, St. Joseph Church, about their new church construction. The project's budget initially grew from under \$10 million to \$17 million over the past two years. After recent detailed planning, the cost was estimated at \$21.6 million. In response, Fr. Paul and Archbishop Hartmayer decided to keep the budget at \$17 million by making the building smaller, with 550 seats in the nave and additional seating in the choir loft and narthex. They also opted to remove the tower foundation, planning for a future freestanding tower. The beloved Prince Avenue stained glass windows will be included in the new building! The Athens-Clarke County Planning and Zoning Commission confirmed that their 2008 land use permit remains valid with a simple amendment. Please keep Fr. Paul and the St. Joseph community in your prayers as they move forward with this important project. In Christ. Fr. Brian
