A Message from Rachel Lichtenwalner

Dear Catholic Center Community,

What if we looked at each other like sunsets?

This summer, I had the great privilege of interning with the Fellowship of Catholic University Students, better known in our community as FOCUS. As much as the experience was professionally developmental, it was also spiritually formative.

An opportunity FOCUS gave us interns to grow in our faith was a weekly speaker series, one of these speakers being Brendan McCauley who lectures for the Theology of the Body Institute. Before his talk, I was familiar with the topic of TOB, but I didn't really know what it entailed.

A question Brendan proposed to us was, "What if we looked at each other like sunsets?" What if we looked at each other deeper, past our outward appearances? What if we delighted in each other's inherent, pure beauty? What if we were mesmerized by each other's dignity and person?

You don't have to exist. Yet, God thought the world needed you. Your life is a gift — a gift to God because He gets to lavish His love on you and a gift to the people He has placed and will place in your life. Theology of the Body is more than sexuality and relationships, I learned; it's about the truth, beauty, and goodness of our humanity.

I truly understood this concept when I recently met with a friend over coffee. We were discussing the beauty of God in His self and in nature, and then my friend looked at me very intently and said, "Rachel, you are so beautiful. There's a whole world inside of you that I can't even see!" My friend referred not to my exterior self but profoundly saw, appreciated, and was amazed by my soul, my heart, my personality, my character — the whole depth, breadth, beauty, preciousness, and complexity of my being.

So, I encourage you to look at people like sunsets, whether they're easy or hard to love, whether they're a close companion or a stranger. Let us put on the eyes of Christ and see one another as purely and as fully as Christ sees us.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion is the formal title of laypeople who distribute the Eucharist during Mass. As the title implies, there are also "ordinary ministers" - those who are literally "ordained" to the ministry namely bishops, priests, and deacons. These ministers are usually the first in order to distribute the Body and Blood of Christ. In most places, especially when Communion is offered under the forms of both bread and wine, there are rarely enough "ordinary" ministers for the timely distribution of Communion.

Communion ministers receive spiritual, theological, and practical preparation to fulfill their role with knowledge and reverence. Such preparation addresses appropriate attire, demeanor, and the manner in which to handle the consecrated bread and wine. While Eucharistic ministers are not ordained, their roles carry spiritual value. A Eucharistic minister's simple duties belie a sacred spiritual mystery. Your willingness to serve as an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist, reflects not only a response to your Baptismal call to serve the people of God, but a commitment to Christ as you share in the preaching, teaching and leading aspects of the church.

By offering the Eucharist, you recognize the Body of Christ in those to whom you minister, and ultimately you act as the Body of Christ by fully participating in the life of the parish and the wider community.
