A Message from Fr. Brian

Friends,

Every now and then, life invites us to stop and pay attention—not to the chaos of the world or even the noise of our own hearts, but to the quiet, unshakable faithfulness of God. This is where I find myself today: standing in awe of how God continues to move, even in the unseen and unfinished parts of our lives.

This season has been anything but simple. There have been stretches where clarity felt far away, and the road ahead seemed veiled in shadow. Yet, in those moments, I've discovered a deeper truth: God does His greatest work not when everything is perfect, but when we allow Him into the imperfect spaces. It's there—in the uncertainty, the tension, and even the weariness that His grace transforms.

What strikes me most is how God chooses to reveal Himself through people. Through you. In your prayers, your presence, your kindness, I have seen the love of Christ made real. This community is not just a collection of individuals; it is a living sign of God's promise that none of us are ever truly alone. Together, we are reminded of what it means to bear one another's burdens and to celebrate the joys that point us back to Him.

Ministry, as I've come to see, isn't about having all the answers or fixing everything. It's about showing up. It's about being present to one another in the way Christ is present to us—fully, vulnerably, and without reserve. And in that showing up, God works. He moves in ways that are subtle and quiet but also earth-shaking in their power.

As I look ahead, I am filled with a holy anticipation for what God is doing among us. I believe we are being called deeper—not to lives of mere survival, but to lives of abundant trust. To lean into His mystery, to take risks for the Gospel, and to allow ourselves to be utterly changed by His love.

So let us go forward together, rooted in a faith that is bold enough to trust in what we cannot yet see. Let us embrace the truth that God is not done with any of us. And let us always, always remember that His faithfulness is the one thing that will never fail.

Thank you for walking this journey with me. You are a testament to God's goodness, and it is an honor to serve alongside you.
